Abstracts must be original and not previously published in other journals nor as e-poster online. Abstracts will not be published if there are plagiarism issues. In particular, abstracts will be rejected if plagiarism exceeds 20%. Abstracts will be published only if written in good English. The authors must be aware that good English is essential for acceptance of the abstracts.
